Second Wine of Château Cadillac

WINE ESTATE Château Cadillac dates back to the 17th century (one of the oldest in Bordeaux), and overlooks a majestic estate covering 75 hectares spread out over three levels.

The estate was bought in 1991 by Jean-Jacques Lesgourgues and is located only 2 miles west from Fronsac.

The Cuvée "JJ Lesgourgues" is produced on only 55 acres from the very old grapes that grow in the slopes and the highest points surrounding the Château.

SOIL Château Cadillac is a single-vineyard estate of the 16th century, located near Fronsac on the same geographical axis as Saint-Emilion. The property is made out of two types of soils: a clay/limestone plateau (20%) and "molasses du Fronsadais" on the slopes (80%).

CHATEAU LA MOULINIÈRE AOC Bordeaux Rouge

80% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon

TASTING NOTES Deep red color. Developed nose of **cassis, raspberry and cherry**. Very fruity in the mouth with fresh **red fruit and earthy spice** flavors leading to a nice, long finish. A very

80% Sauvignon Blanc, 20% Semillon

TASTING NOTES aromas and with hints of **citrus and green apple**. Sauvignon dominates on the nose. Rich on the palate with good acidity. A long, **fresh** finish. A great summer drink or aperitif.
